# Research Information Management at ISCTE-IUL: The Library's role

#### **ABSTRACT**

ISCTE-IUL is a portuguese public university with approximately 9000 students enrolled in undergraduate (46%) and postgraduate (54%) programs. The Repository of ISCTE-IUL is running since 2007 sustained by an Open Access policy approved in the same year. In 2013, the current research information system - Ciência-IUL - became interoperable with the Repository bringing new challenges to *Documentation and Information Services* that include the ISCTE-IUL Library, allowing to work collaboratively with other services to collect information, improve processes, and reduce duplication of efforts. *Documentation and Information Services* seek to support researchers throughout the research life cycle aiming to raise awareness of the academic community for Open Science best practices.
