| | Centrism | High (controls for voters' variance; more accurate if the median is used) |

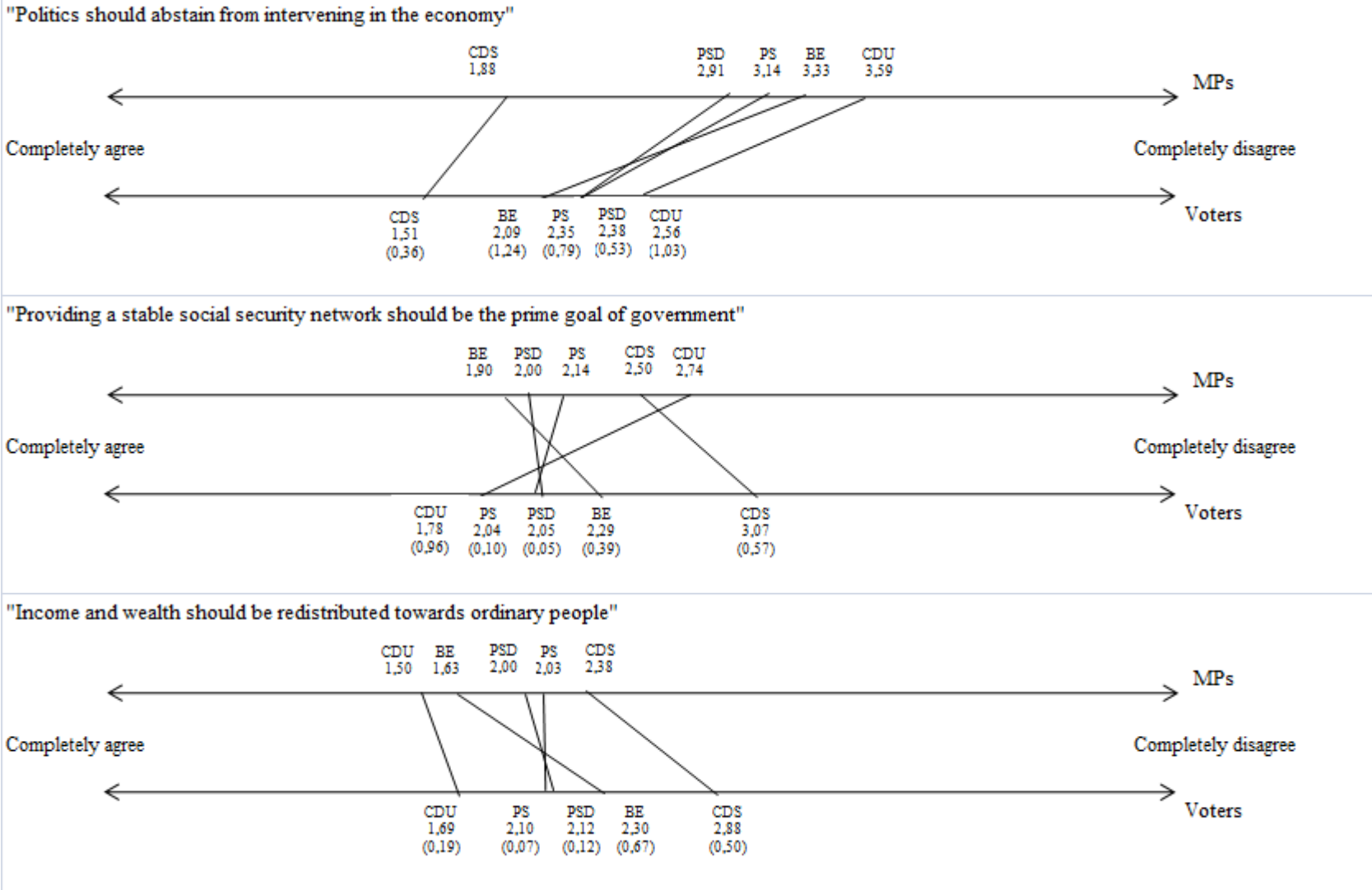

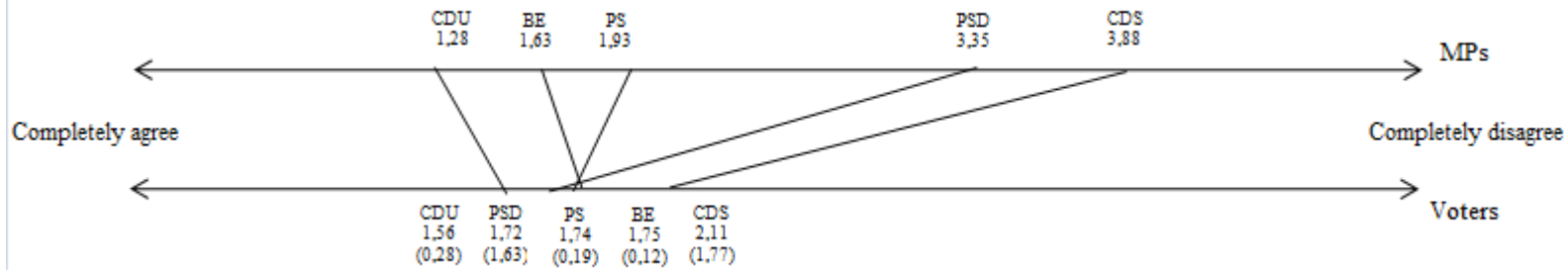

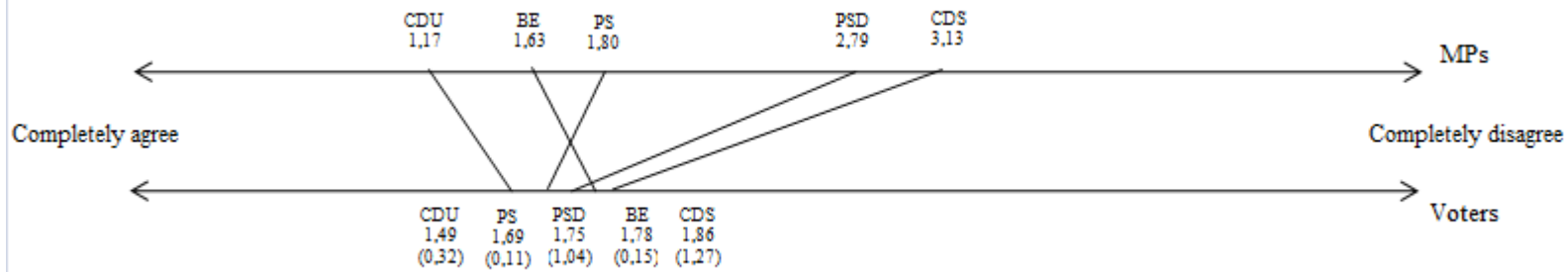
Figure 2. Mean distances between MPs and voters referring to left-right policy issues



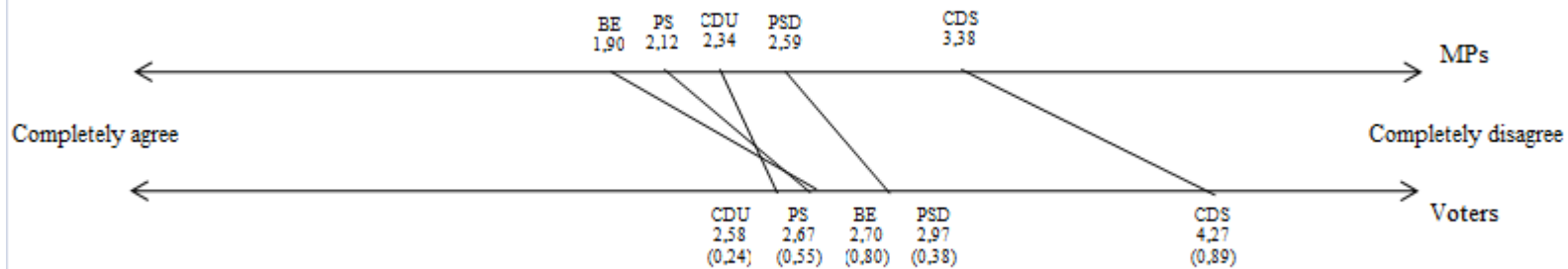

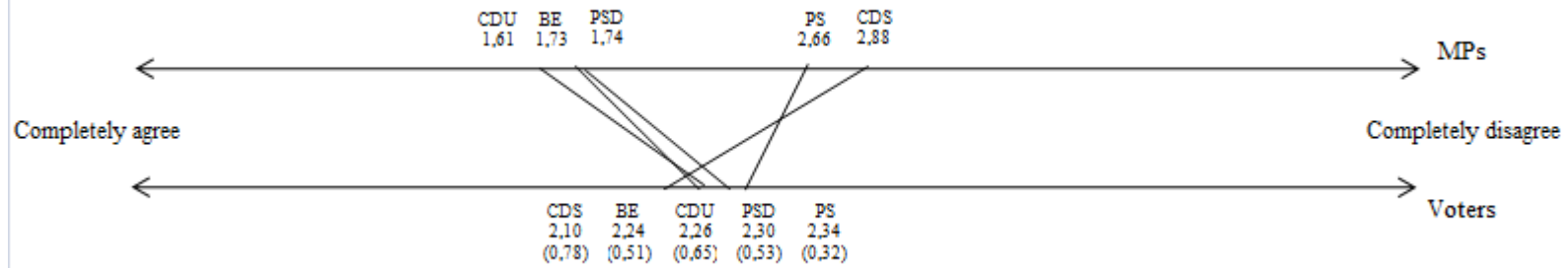
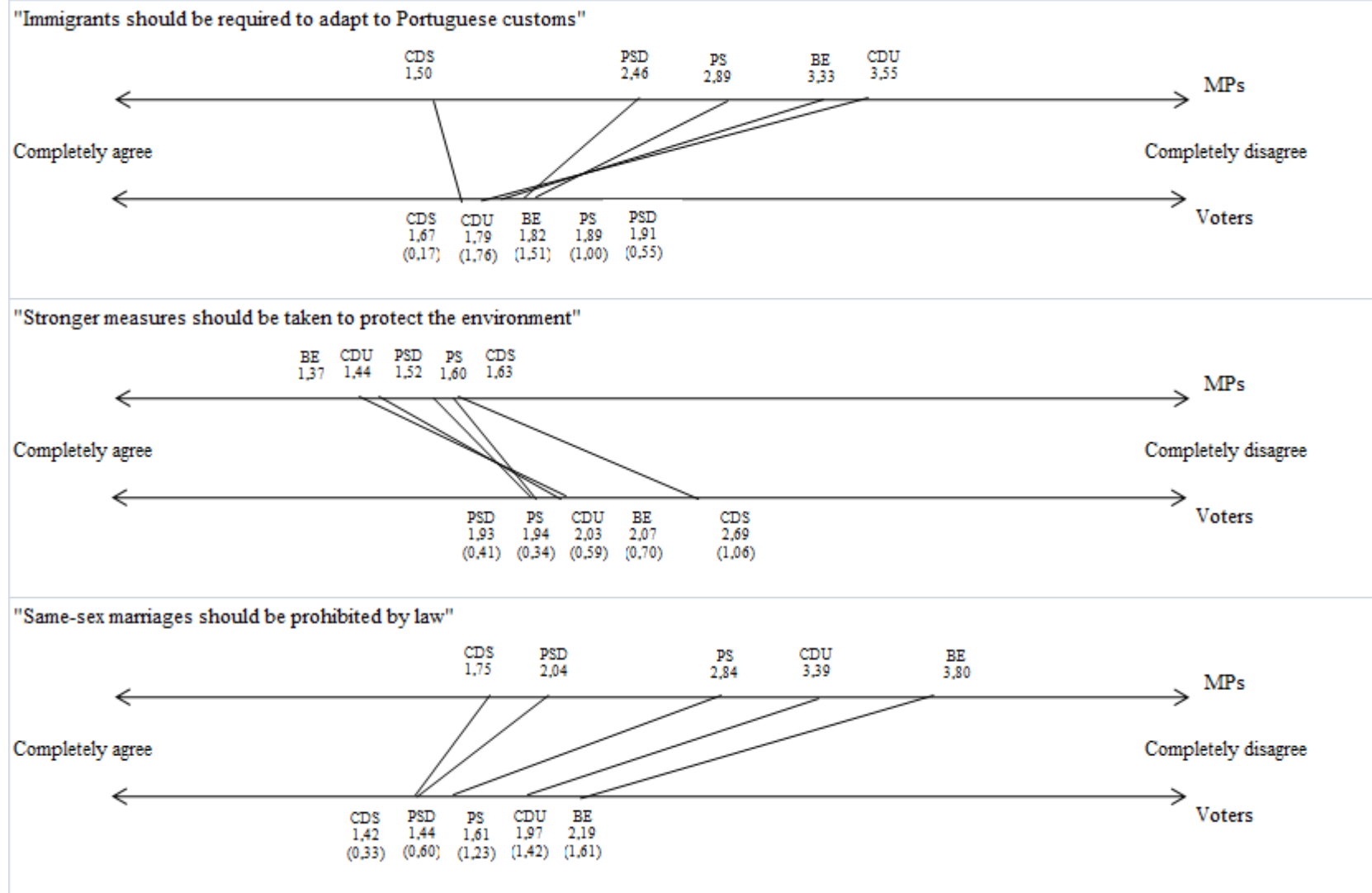
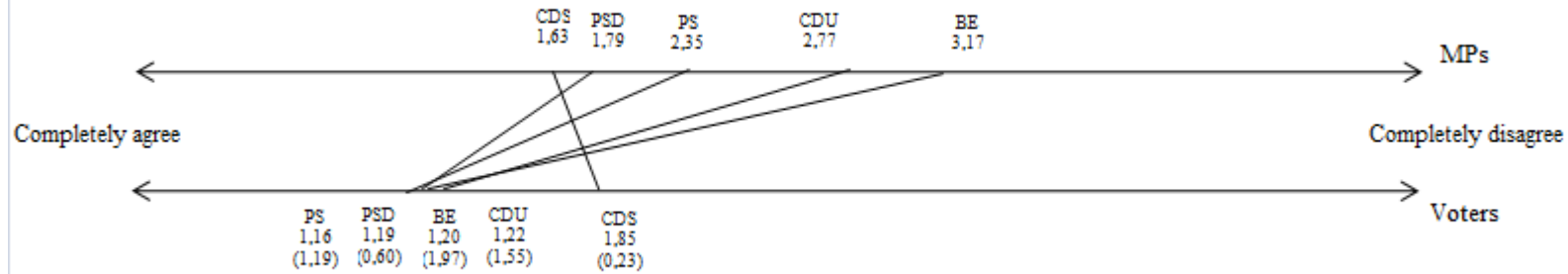


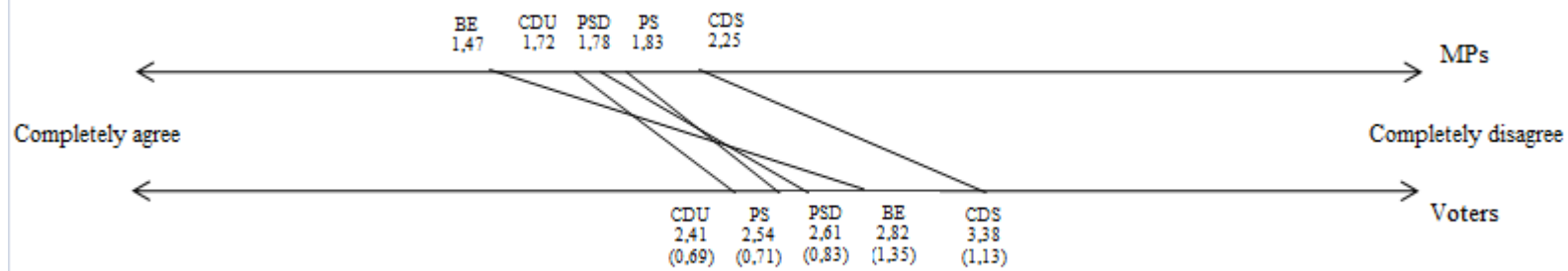
Figure 3. Mean distances between MPs and voters referring to libertarian-authoritarian policy issues



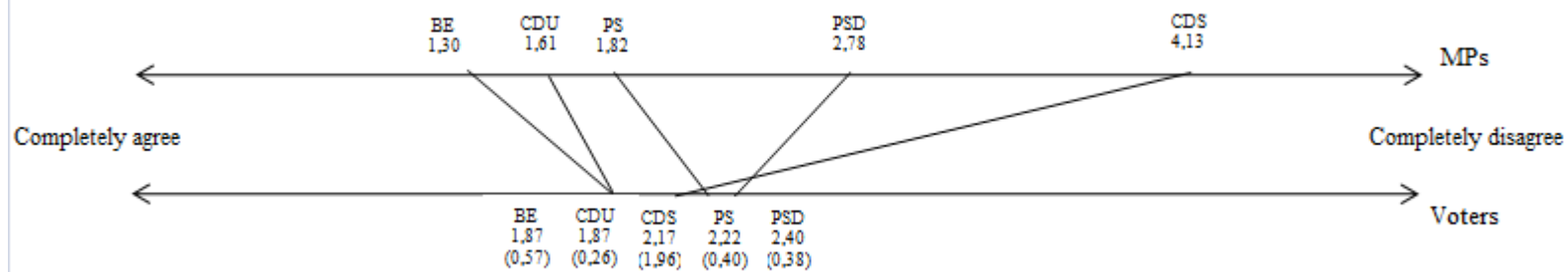

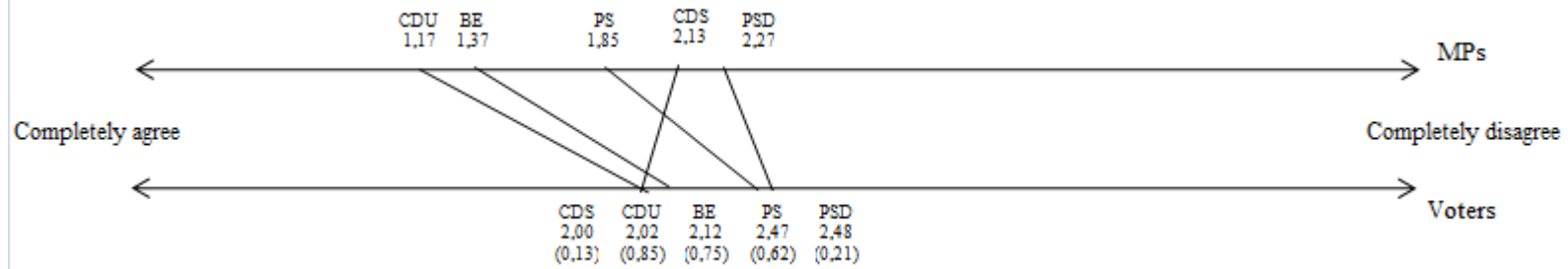

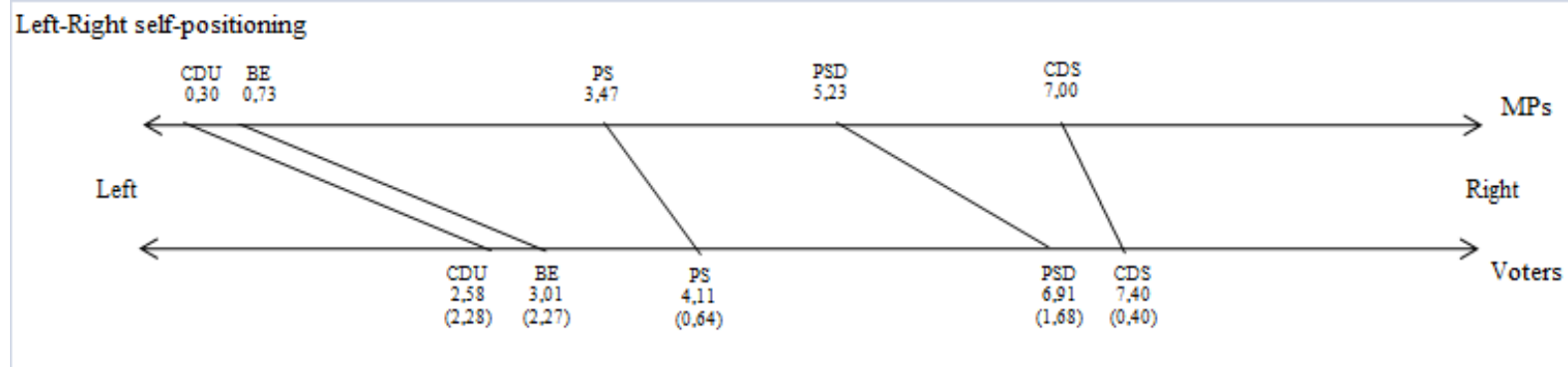

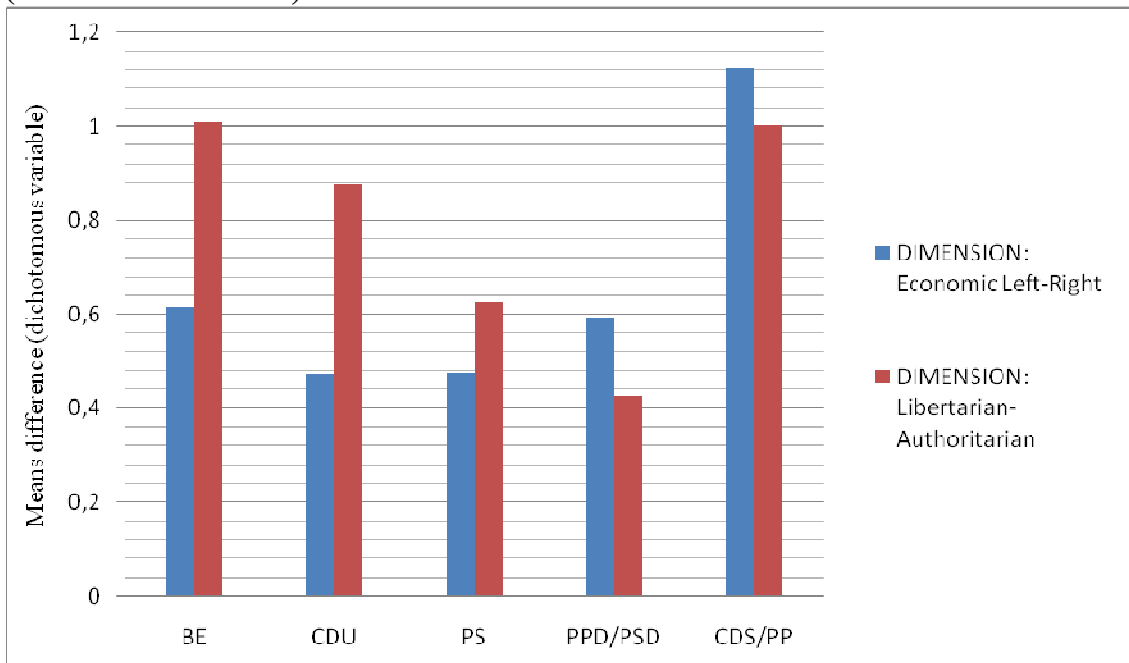

Figure 6. Standardized mean differences across policy dimensions (the mean of means)

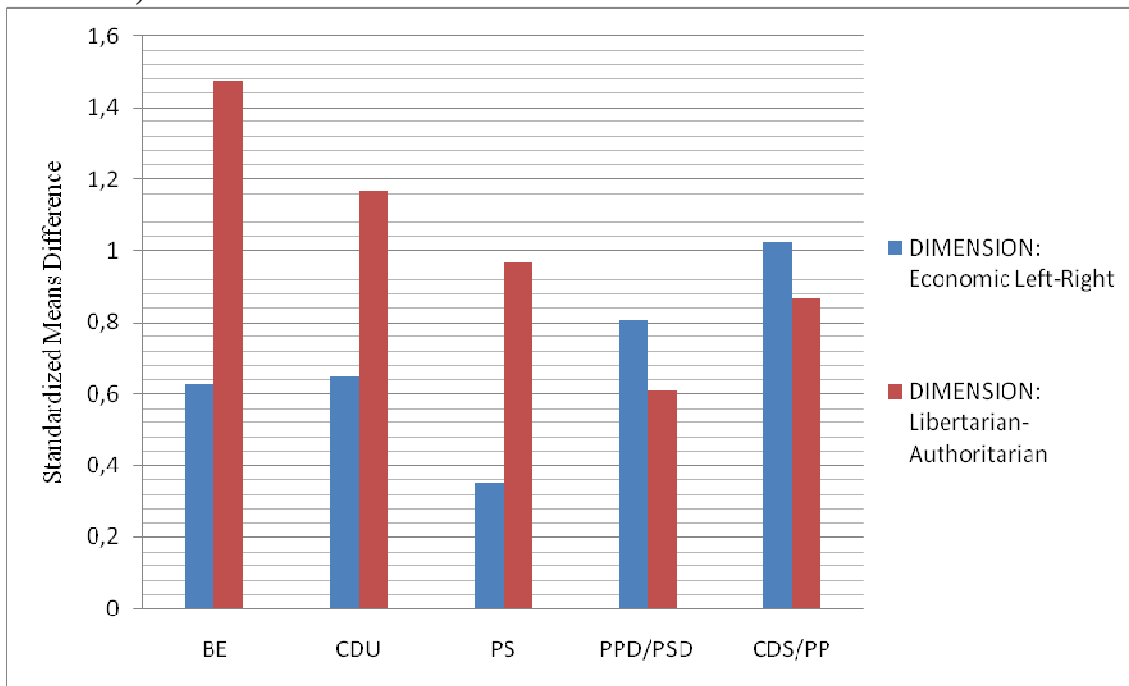
