


Figure 1: Research Hypotheses for the Three Models

The three models:	Higher congruence is expected:
Downs - May (Spatial Voting Theory & Law of Curvilinear Disparities)	H1a: Among politically sophisticated and involved voters and with a high level of education. H1b: Among MPs with high political experience and with accurate perceptions on voters' positions. H1c: Among political parties with high cohesion and low intra-party polarization.
Przeworski - Sprague (Party competition theory)	H2: Among political parties whose electoral competition is closer to the ideological centre.
Huber-Powell-Wessels (Party system / Institutional explanations)	H3: In more differentiated and proportional electoral systems.


